

Planned City Centre Road Closures – April and May 2022

<p><u>Blandford Square</u></p>	<p>Legal order from 8th November, lasting for 6 months. Phased works to minimise disruption. For the duration of the works the one-way restrictions will be suspended to allow access around the closed sections.</p> <p>Underground pipework installation</p>
<p><u>Erick Street and Cross Carliol Street</u></p>	<p>Legal order from 10th November, lasting for 9 months. The closure will be in operation when the relevant signs are displayed.</p> <p>Adjacent building demolition</p>
<p><u>Westgate Hill Terrace</u></p>	<p>Legal order from 22nd November, lasting for 5 months. Works will be carried out in 2 phases to maintain access to the residents parking at the back of Summerhill Terrace.</p> <p>Installation of underground pipework</p>

<p><u>Ridley Place</u> – and a section of Vine Lane</p>	<p>Legal order from 24th January, lasting for 40 weeks.</p> <p>Drainage works and public realm improvement work</p>
<p><u>Strawberry Lane</u></p>	<p>Legal order from 12th February, lasting for 15 weeks. Closure will only be in place as and when necessary with appropriate diversion and advance warning signs placed on the adjacent highway network.</p> <p>Construction work on adjacent land</p>

<u>Saville Row and North Street</u>	<p>Legal order from 28th February, lasting for 12 months.</p> <p>Health and safety whilst drainage works are carried out, followed by public realm improvement work.</p>
<u>Pilgrim Street area</u>	<p>Legal order from 16th March, initially in place for 18 months.</p> <p>Market Street fully closed between 4th April and 8th May, then closed eastbound only for the remainder of the Legal Order. Pilgrim Street fully closed between 16th May and 24th June, then subject to southbound lane closures for the remainder of the Legal Order</p> <p>Health and safety during construction</p>
<u>Scotswood Road (Times Square)</u> - Between Neville Street and Marlborough Crescent.	<p>Closure from 25th March till 29th August</p> <p>Safe running of Central Park events</p>
<u>Worswick Street</u>	<p>On-going works extended. Legal order starts 21st April, lasting for 8 weeks. One-way restriction will be suspended to allow access and egress from the section of the street that is not closed. Bus Only Street restriction, westbound on Market Street will be suspended to allow this to be used as a diversion route.</p> <p>Utilities works</p>
<u>High Level Bridge</u>	<p>Legal order from 25th April, lasting for 2 weeks. Closure in place between 11:00pm – 06:00am.</p> <p>Health and safety during bridge maintenance works</p>
<u>College Lane</u> – section opposite College Street car park	<p>Legal order from 26th April, lasting for 1 week, closure expected to be in place for 1 day (26th). Entry will be maintained to College Street Car Park via the exit road.</p> <p>Utilities works</p>
<u>George Street</u> – section between Elswick Terrace	<p>Legal order from 3rd May, lasting for two months. It is anticipated that work be completed over one night.</p> <p>Health and safety during contractor reconstruction / resurfacing works</p>
<u>Tyne Bridge area</u>	<p>Legal order starts 16th May, lasting for 8 weeks. It is expected that the Tyne Bridge will be fully closed from 13th June to 1st July between the hours of 10:00pm – 6:00am, with the roads under the Tyne Bridge closed from 16th May to 10th June between the hours of 8:00pm – 6:00am.</p> <p>Health and safety during essential works</p>
