### What this programme is

- Support programme to help UK and Ukrainian universities co-develop Horizon Europe proposals.
- Delivered by Cormack Consultancy Group (CCG) with support from the UK FCDO and UK and Ukraine Horizon Europe offices.
- Continuation of the UK–Ukraine Twinning Initiative; focused on practical help to build multilateral consortia and shape proposals.



### How it helps your team

#### Find the right partners

Targeted partner introductions and virtual matchmaking events.

#### Turn ideas into proposals

 Short briefings, concept labs, drop-in clinics, and light-touch expert feedback.

#### Stay on top of opportunities

• Simple updates on relevant Horizon Europe calls in late 2025 / early 2026.

#### Learn what works

Shared tips and examples from participating institutions.



## How to get involved (quick start)

1) Share your project idea (UA universities)

Complete one registration form per concept by 27 October 2025 – only UA universities.

2) Book a short institutional briefing

A 30-minute call to align on interests and next steps, after submitting the concept note.

- 3) Join the virtual matchmaking November and January events to meet potential partners.
- 4) Use the development support Co-design lab in November; drop-in clinic in February.
- 5) Stay updated
  Sign up for the bi-monthly newsletter for calls and tips.



# Getting started (Oct 2025)

#### What happens

- Kick-off webinar
- 1:1 institutional briefings
- First newsletter with opportunities.

- Submit your idea form by 27 Oct (one per concept) for UA universities
- Emails us if you already have a project under development and are looking for UA partners *for UK universities*
- Book a briefing slot.



# Finding the right calls & partners (Oct 2025– Feb 2026)

#### What happens

We flag suitable calls and collect partner interest to make introductions.

- Tell us your themes and strengths
- Respond to introductions; meet potential partners.



# Building your consortium (Nov 2025–Jan 2026)

#### What happens

- Two virtual matchmaking events (Nov & Jan)
- Simple partner info packs to help you choose who to meet.

- Prepare a 3-minute pitch
- Shortlist partners and schedule follow-ups.



# Developing your proposal (Nov 2025–Feb 2026)

#### What happens

- Co-design lab (Nov) for teams aiming at near-term calls
- Drop-in clinic (Feb) for final questions
- Light-touch expert reviews (limited slots).

- Bring a short concept note or draft
- Request a review if your project is a good fit.

#### Nov-Feb

 We help match you to calls and partners; ongoing introductions.

#### Nov & Jan

 Virtual matchmaking events; quick partner pitches and follow-ups.

#### Nov-Feb

 Hands-on support: co-design lab (Nov), drop-in clinic (Feb), light-touch reviews.

• Your idea is shaped into a clear, competitive proposal plan.

 You know key dates and support options, and who to contact for quick help.
